



PSALM SERMON #4

- The person who accepts God's principles as defined in His word understands that he/she must find his refuge in God also.
- You have to trust God.
- Psalm 2 is God's viewpoint of human history.
- God has one single answer for human history, Jesus, His anointed one.
- All scripture is "God breathed". God inspired the writers, but the personalities still show through in the scriptures.
- Anthropomorphisms are used by David in his writings in Psalm.
- Anthropomorphic is defined as ascribing human form or attributes to a being or thing not human, esp. to a deity.
- Government thinks it can limit the powers of God on earth.
- The "moral majority" tried to make the church political. It caused a considerable backlash that is still felt today.
- We are the salt of the earth. We are the light of the world. Why do we need politics?
- Why would we rely on government to accomplish our purpose? Morality cannot be legislated nor can it be suppressed.
- It is the transforming of the mind that changes the way a person acts.
- When you live the life you are supposed to live you don't have to worry about your impact on society.
- God's wrath and anger comes from His absolute and perfect righteousness.
- Man functions in terms of relative righteousness, not absolute.
- Our righteousness will never be good enough. It is God's imputed righteousness to us and that's what makes us stand in front of God.

PSALM SERMON #4

- God's righteousness does not change.
- Blessed are all who take refuge in Him.
- Life comes down to choices. You determine your life by the choices you make.
- Choices are guided by viewpoint.
- If you make your choices from God's viewpoint you will be blessed.
- Our challenge is to live consistently with what we believe is true.
- If you choose in conflict with what you believe you will live in misery.
- Ruth 2:11 – 12
- Place yourself under God's wings.
- Why would we trust anything else other than under God's wing.
- Psalm 22:8
- Those who believe get a lifeline from God.
- Psalm 7:1 – 2
- If we don't trust God we will live in a life that is gripped by fear.
- We are not to be fearful.
- Do you know what will happen tomorrow? No, but you do know that Jesus will still be on His throne and He will still be protecting you.
- What is our response to fear? Trust in God!
- Romans 8:31 – 39
- Nothing can separate us from His love.
- All you need to do is accept what Jesus did for you.
- Every day you can take what God says to be true and live it in your life and it can be meaningful.
- Trust in and take your refuge in God everyday!
