



## PSALM SERMON #7

- Psalm 4
- A lot of times we perceive that we are the ones who hear and everyone else is deaf. That's a bad precedent for studying God's word.
- God has his own agenda and his own understanding of everything.
- We don't have all the answers but we have the promise of Jesus to lead and teach us all truth.
- We need to allow the Holy Spirit to teach us individually. He will meet us where we are at on our journey.
- Any relationship to God has to be on the basis of grace.
- There is nothing we can do of our own merit that would impress God.
- David received because he went to God with his hands open.
- Don't let your emotions lead you to sin.
- What does it mean to sacrifice?
- God only accepted the sacrifice of His son.
- Psalm 107:22
- We are what we are and we have what we have based on His sacrifice. Be thankful for that. Nothing else would have been enough than the sacrifice of Jesus Christ.
- Is there any that does not sin?
- We always think we have to do something to save ourselves. It's contradictory to scripture.
- Trusting in God takes it out of your hands, but it is the only way it works.

## PSALM SERMON #7

- You don't have a part in God's acceptance of you.
- God gets all the credit for his relationship with you. He did all of the work.
- To be redeemed means to be purchased with a price.
- God gave Adam everything with just one requirement.
- Adam died spiritually when he sinned against God. It created a problem for everyone.
- In Adam all die. We are born dead.
- God's judgment system is NOT based on what you do. It's based on whether you are spiritually alive or not. You were born spiritually dead.
- In order to redeem our dead spirit we needed a person born qualified to pay the redemption costs.
- The only person ever to meet that qualification was Jesus.
- Jesus was the only person ever born spiritually alive.
- Jesus was qualified to pay the price of sin. The purchase price was death.
- Jesus was the only person who was born spiritually alive, therefore, the only person who could have redeemed us.
- Do you believe your sacrifice is better than his?
- Say "Yes" to God and the redemption He has provided for you.
